

Lash Lift Instruction Card

1. Apply gel pads and tape to the clients lower lash line preventing any lower lashes from curling upwards and attaching to the shields.
 2. Using the skin adhesive apply a thin layer to the back of the shield, apply shield to the eyelids.
 3. Apply solution #1 (perm) to the base and middle of the clients lashes. Depending on the natural lashes leave solution on for 5-8 minutes. Clients with finer/ thin natural lashes process for 5 minutes, clients with courser natural lashes process for 8 minutes.
 4. Using an applicator wand remove solution from clients lashes.
 5. Apply solution #2 (set) to the base and middle of the clients lashes. Process for the same amount of time as that of solution #1. Clients with finer/ thin natural lashes process for 5 minutes, clients with courser natural lashes process for 8 minutes.
 6. Using an applicator wand remove solution from natural lashes.
 7. Apply solution #3 (nourish) to the clients natural lashes. This solution is used to remove the lashes from the shield as well as repair the natural lashes after the treatment.
 8. Once the lashes have been removed from the shield, using a damp applicator wand (saturated with water) start removing the shields from the clients lid. Please note both water or step #3 can be used to remove the shields from the clients eyelids, we personally prefer using an applicator wand and water to do so.
- If a tint is requested, perform this step after solution #2, before the nourishing solution is applied. Please note, after lash lifting has been performed the client should not get their lashes we for 12 hours to ensure optimal results.



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
